UNIFORM

We will continue to have a uniform draw each term on a random day when all the children, who are in the correct school uniform on that day will have their names go into a hat and one will be picked out for each class. The winner will receive a £3 WH Smith voucher. This is to help support our uniform policy. If you are having any difficulties purchasing uniform then please speak to the school office.

Please make sure that any long hair e.g. reaching shoulders is tied back and avoid elaborate accessories.

HRH QUEEN ELIZBETH II

Today we joined with the rest of the country to mourn the loss of our Queen, Elizabeth II. We had time in assembly to reflect on her long, successful and remarkable reign. We were impressed with how many objects, representing the Queen, the children could identify and explain.

Staff also touched upon this historic event in classes with the children but ensured that we celebrated the woman and leader she was.

We explained to the children that from Monday, we will open a Book of Condolence which will be kept in the hall. The children can write their messages in or draw a picture in her memory and we will send this on to the palace in a few weeks' time. The opportunity to add to the book is extended to parents and carers who may also wish to add their own messages.

We do understand that the news may be received very differently by children and their families. We recognize that over the next few weeks our children will be hearing and seeing the news. For some individuals this may trigger a range of emotions that could feel confusing or difficult. DATA COLLECTION

At the start of every academic year, we update our contact details for the children. I'm sure you can appreciate it is imperative that we have up to date information in case of an emergency.

If you haven't done so already, and you need to notify us of any changes, please complete the blank form attached and return it by Monday to prevent office staff having to chase. If you are sure that your details have not changed, please email the office to confirm that there are no changes. Thank you.

BIRTHDAYS

We will continue to celebrate your child's birthday in school with our birthday stickers and table top badge. Please remember not bring in things to hand out such as sweets, cakes etc. for the whole class as we are trying to promote healthy eating and are also not allowed items to be brought in from home. MEET THE TEACHER

Next week we are inviting parents to our 'Meet the Teacher' sessions. This is for you to meet the teacher who will teaching your child/ren and for them to share with you how the class is set up and explain the expectations for behaviour, communication, learning, homework etc. We have planned the following dates so that parents and carers with more than one child can attend.

REMINDERS

Please can we remind you that pack lunches from home must be **NUT FREE**, including chocolate spreads containing nuts. We continue to promote healthy eating in school and therefore ask that chocolate bars and sweets are not included in packed lunches. Small chocolate covered biscuits – Kit Kats, Pengiun bars etc are fine. As a rule of thumb, if it is in the biscuit aisle, it is a biscuit; therefore ok in school.

COATS

Please ensure that your child brings a coat to school every day as the weather is very changeable and we will always aim to have children outside for play and lunch if possible.

KS2 FRUIT AND SNACKS



All KSI and EYFS children are given a fruit or vegetable snack through the government healthy school initiative. If you would like your child to receive this in KS2 then you will need to order through the office. The cost of this is £3 per term.

If you wish your child to bring in a snack from home then please make sure that it is only fresh fruit or vegetables, thank you.

SCHOOL DINNERS

From September, a daily lunch for KS2 children will cost £2.42. If you would like to pay for the whole of the first term the price will be £84.70. Just a reminder that pupils moving into Year 3 will have to register for Parent pay if their child is having paid school dinners from September. The school office sent out the registration codes on Monday. Please let the office know if you haven't received this. The menu for this term was sent home before the holidays and can be found on the school website.

Please could everyone ensure that their parent pay accounts have no outstanding balances at the end of every week. This will help the office as we will not have to chase any debt owed as this can take up a lot of time for office staff. If there remains an outstanding balance on a Friday, you will be asked to send a packed lunch in for the following week, or until the debt is paid.

BREAKFAST CLUB

Breakfast club has started on a **Monday** and **Wednesday** starting from **7:45am**. Children are provided with a nutritious breakfast, compromising of a choice of healthy cereals, toast, fruit, yoghurt or pancakes. Children will participate in an activity until 8:35am when they will be walked back to their classrooms ready for the start of the school day.

The sessions are £5 per child per session, which will include breakfast and participation in the activity that day. This can be paid for by BACs or cheque to the school office. To ensure the sustainability of the club we will require parents and carers to sign up to this termly, as we need 2 members of staff to run it. You can select your days and we will offer places on a first come, first served basis. You do, however, need to book a minimum of I session per week. If you would like to book a place from September for the first term, please contact the school office. Places must be booked in advance and you will then be contacted to confirm your place.

On **Thursdays** Sports Cool Brighton will be offering a morning club. This will be £5 per session which should be made to the school office. This will start at **8am** and children will also be offered breakfast. Sports Cool Brighton will bring a variety of games and activities dependant on group size, ages and weather, such as archery, frisbee, and golf etc. They will also have games like lenga, connect 4, and dominoes for those who prefer quiet time.

AFTER SCHOOL CLUBS

Unfortunately due to staffing and low numbers, SportsCool have had to postpone the clubs they were hoping to run in Term 1. They are however offering a football club on a Friday afternoon. They hope to introduce, basketball and Dodgeball etc in term 2 if there is enough interest.

Gemma will continue to run craft club, also on a Friday afternoon. Please see the attached booking form. Many of you have asked about the return of Lego Club. We hope to be able to offer this in Term 2 which we will confim near the end of T1.

We hope to offer the children more of a variety of clubs soon, and will keep you all updated.

PARKING

Please can we ask everyone to be mindful of safety when driving and parking on Church Lane and in the village car park. Our neighbours have been in touch due to cars already blocking their driveway. This is frustrating for them in accessing their property so please allow extra time to park and drive slowly down the lane, thank you.

FOREST SCHOOL

We will be commencing our Forest School sessions on Thursday afternoons with Year 2 starting next week. Each term there will be a programme for a different year group.

QUEENS GREEN CANOPY

We are involved in an exciting project with the village in planting trees in celebration of the Queens Jubilee. This was shared with the children this week in assembly.

We have ordered 100 saplings so that every child can plant and name a tree. These will be planted on the Glebe land on the far side behind Reverend Geoffrey's house.

The tree should arrive in early November and we will have a planting day and ceremony later in that month. If you would like to be involved in this project or have any experience in tree planting/ design then please let the office know.



ECO GROUP

Next week Mr Herdman will be talking to the children in assembly in about Eco group and asking them to apply to be Eco Warriors. The new Eco Group will be playing a big part in our Queens canopy Project too as well as improving the energy efficiency in school.
