SCHOOL LUNCHES

Just to remind you that school lunches for KS2 children cost £2.42 daily, these need to be paid in advance. If you are unable to pay in advance then please make sure that you clear any arrears at the end of each week. If arrears are not cleared your child will have to have a packed lunch.

CTS NEWSLETTER

Please see attached. It covers self-care sessions, coffee mornings, and training workshops. Many of these sessions are free and reminders at a subsidised cost.

FIXED PENALTY NOTICES

You may remember that we have recently rewritten our attendance policy, taking advice from ESBAS (East Sussex Behaviour and Attendance Service), who regularly come in to work with us as a federation and to monitor our practice. We have become much more rigorous in our attendance monitoring and will now be asking ESBAS to issue penalty notices for lateness as well as absence, you will be informed by letter if you are at risk of this. The policy can be viewed on our website in statutory information and policies.

EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

If we need to close the school due to severe weather etc. then we will first put a message on our website and contact the Local Authority for our school name to be put on their school closures list on their website. We will also email parents and carers as soon as possible and encourage the message to be shared via What App groups. If the school needs to be closed, for any reason whilst the children are in school, we will email first and then start calling families to cascade the information. It is really important that we have the correct contact details for you so please make sure that any change in email, phone number or address has been received by the school office for our records, thank you.

Our school website should be the key source for information so if you cannot find anything on there or it is difficult to see then please let us know as we are working on it this term to make it more user friendly.
