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### **PUPIL PREMIUM**

If you are in receipt of any of the following benefits:

Income Support, Income-based Jobseekers Allowance, Income-related Employment and Allowance Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999, Child Tax Credit (provided they are not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190, as assessed by Her Majesty's Revenue and Customs) or some forms of Working Tax Credit, your child may be eligible for funding.

You can apply online through East Sussex County Council. This year the school received a grant of £1320 per pupil. This money is spent on additional staff to support small group work or in class support. It can also be used for resources, to help fund trips and uniform etc for these children. Please see Mrs Brown or Mrs West if you think you may be eligible to apply. All conversations will be held in the strictest confidence. This applies to all children from Reception to Year 6 irrelevant of whether they are receiving the government initiative of infant free school meals. As many of you may be aware school budgets are quite tight and we seek funding wherever we can to help provide for all the children in our care.

Application for FSM (free school meals) is through ESCC on-line, parents have to enter their NI number and are checked for eligibility by return.
