- Our weekly parent child reading sessions started again this week. The 15 minute session starts at 2.45pm and takes place in Underwater class, so please meet us by our gate.
- Our welly walks for Reception children leave at 9am every Friday. We always welcome any parent helpers!
- Please let us know when your child needs a new reading book by writing the title and a short comment in the green Communication Diary.
- Please can the Communication Diary and school reading books come into school every day in the named zippy wallet provided.
- We have a 'Wow' class celebration assembly on a Thursday when your child can share exciting news from home including your wow slip comments. Your child can also bring in a named object from home to talk about.

Please see the attached documents for details of what our pupils will be learning this term so that you can support your child at home. If you feel you can support us in any areas of learning, please let us know.

Home Activities: Weekly Home Learning Activities are copied onto pink paper to make them visible!

Please help your child to reach the expected levels at the end of Reception and be school ready for Year One, by completing the homework every week in the new yellow challenge book.

It is also important for you to help your child to learn their key words and to ideally read our scheme books for around 5 minutes every day. It helps to play letter, word and number games to help your child recognise the sounds A-Z and the numbers 1-10, building to 20 in a variety of contexts.

Your child can also use his or her Challenge Book to practise writing cursive letters building to words. We will share it in class and this may even earn a school reward!
