What fascinating facts can you find out to amaze your family, friends and teachers?</p>	<p>Go on a bridge hunt with your grown ups around the local area, taking photographs to show your class. What types of bridge did you see? Choose the most interesting bridge and see what you can discover about it online or at the local library?</p>	<p>Use a world map or globe to find and locate all the famous landmarks you would like to visit. Which continents are they in? How would you get there? Make a travel guide showing images of your favourite places and give information about each country or city.</p>
<p><u>I like to make things and be creative.</u></p>	 <p>Design and create a model of a famous structure from around the world, using junk materials found at home. Will you choose London Bridge, the Leaning tower of Pisa or perhaps the Statue of Liberty? Find a photograph of your chosen landmark to use as inspiration.</p>		
	<p>Build the tallest tower you can at home. Talk to a grown up first about what you can use to build it. Before you knock it down, take a picture to show us in school.</p>		<p>Design a device for catching Giants, and label it with detail about how it works. What materials will you use? What will you need to think about? (e.g. the size of the Giant, the strength of the Giant, whether there will be some bait in the trap to lure the Giant inside.)</p>
<p><u>I like to draw and paint.</u></p>	<p>Paint or draw the forest that grew up around Sleeping Beauty's castle. What kind of trees and creatures would be in that forest?</p>	<p>Draw a detailed diagram of a castle, you could do this by hand or using a computer program. Can you label interesting features which might be found inside, or out?</p>	<p>Design a fantastic new landmark for your local area! What materials would you use and what special features would it have? Think about how to make it stand out from other landmarks in the world. Plot your landmark on a map of your local area. Present your ideas to your class and perhaps take a vote for the winning design.</p>
