CURRICULUM

We have adapted our curriculum this year to help the children transition back into school learning and to reflect on any missed learning during lockdown. We are calling this a 'recovery curriculum' as it is to regain skills and build on previous learning whilst also recognising skills that were developed at home when the children weren't attending school.



The topic theme is around Sandra Diekmann's book 'Leaf' and all classes across both schools are taking this terms learning from it.

This means that children in different classes will be able to discuss their learning at home with siblings, and at school staff can share ideas with one another. It will allow us to cater for all children's abilities as each class teacher will develop their planning around the needs of their class. They can support one another for any gaps in learning from lockdown.
