In addition to the workshops, the children will have opportunities to visit the 'mud kitchen' and the adventure playground. Please note: **it is very muddy! Therefore it is vital that all children wear wellies and old, home clothes, with a waterproof coat and waterproof trousers (if possible). If your child does not have waterproof trousers, please ensure they bring spare clothing. Children must also bring a pair of shoes in a plastic bag, so that they can take muddy wellies off before boarding the coach on the way home.**

We will need a total of 4 parent helpers to support this visit. If we have too many volunteers for the trip, we will draw names from a hat and will contact you, as soon as we can, to confirm whether you will be required on the day.

The children will need to arrive at school as normal on the day and will arrive back at school by 3pm for the end of the day.

For this day children will need:

- Waterproof coat
- Waterproof trousers (or a spare set of clothes)
- Trainers/shoes
- Wellies
- Water bottle
- A packed lunch, which can be provided by the school for every child (please fill in the form below).

Packed lunches from home should not contain fizzy drinks or glass bottles.

Please ensure all items are named and are carried in a named backpack: there will be a space provided at Wilderness Woods for bags and lunches, while we are exploring and engaging in workshops.
